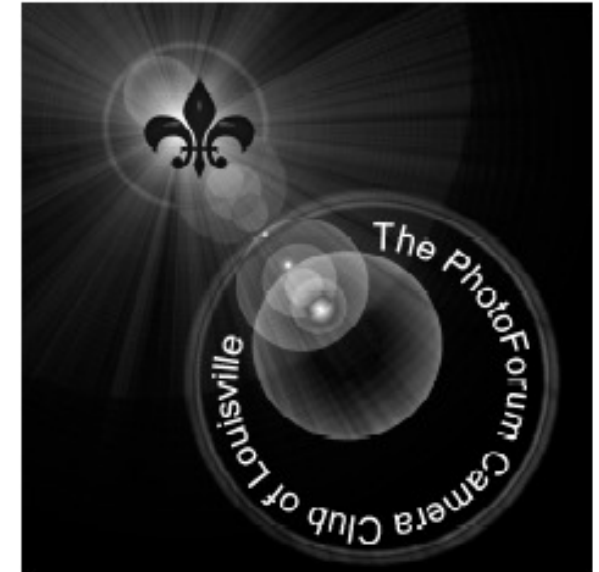

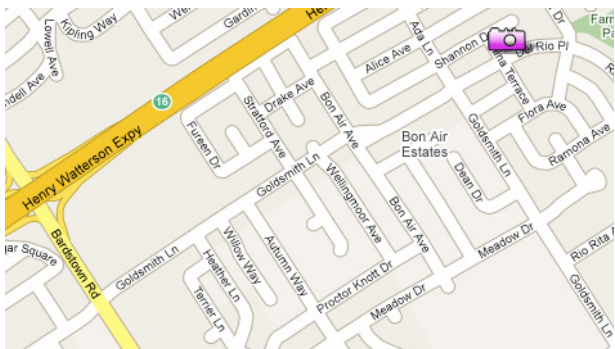

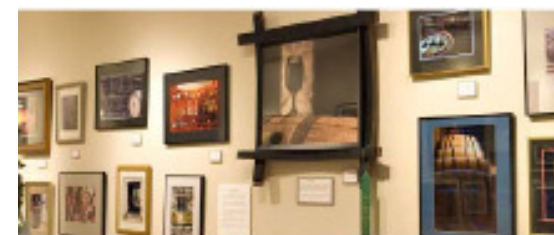
Our Photo Field Trips

Group field trips are among our favorite activities. Members travel near and far to photograph special events, architecture, and natural beauty, to name a few of our subjects. We organize trips and provide information about destinations and photographic opportunities. Members may make arrangements to carpool, but transportation and lodging is up to each individual. Some of our recent trips include various locales around Louisville, such as Woodford Reserve Distillery, Missouri Botanical Gardens in St. Louis, and the Krohn Conservatory and Union Terminal in Cincinnati. And, occasionally we gain special access or tours that allow us to get

those exceptional shots. We usually travel to Reelfoot Lake each January to photograph Bald Eagles and other wildlife. We strive to have fun, make some great photographs and enjoy the spark that comes from a shared creative endeavor. In other words, "We Do Photography."
